**Project Description**

- Proposal: Install a 10-inch gasoline pipeline under Jersey Pike at the Norfolk Southern Railroad crossing to connect Magellan's two storage tank facilities; one on the east and one on west side of Jersey Pike (parcels 138A-B-002 and 129P-B-006).

**Site Analysis****Site Description**

- Location: Jersey Pike at the Norfolk Southern Railroad crossing approximately 1,845 feet north of the Highway 153 overpass and approximately 1,570 feet south of Bonny Oaks Drive.
- Right-of-Way Width: Approximately 67 feet.
- Tennessee Department of Transportation Functional Classification: Urban Minor Arterial.
- Current Land Uses: Petroleum storage and distribution facilities, office and other industrial uses are located north of the request area. Petroleum storage and distribution facilities and quarry site are located south of the request area.
- Based on Hamilton County GIS mapping, there does not appear to be any existing gasoline pipelines within the Jersey Pike right-of-way.

**Zoning History**

- The site is currently zoned M-1 Manufacturing.
- The properties within a 1,000 foot radius of the site are zoned M-1 Manufacturing.

**Plans/Policies/Regulations**

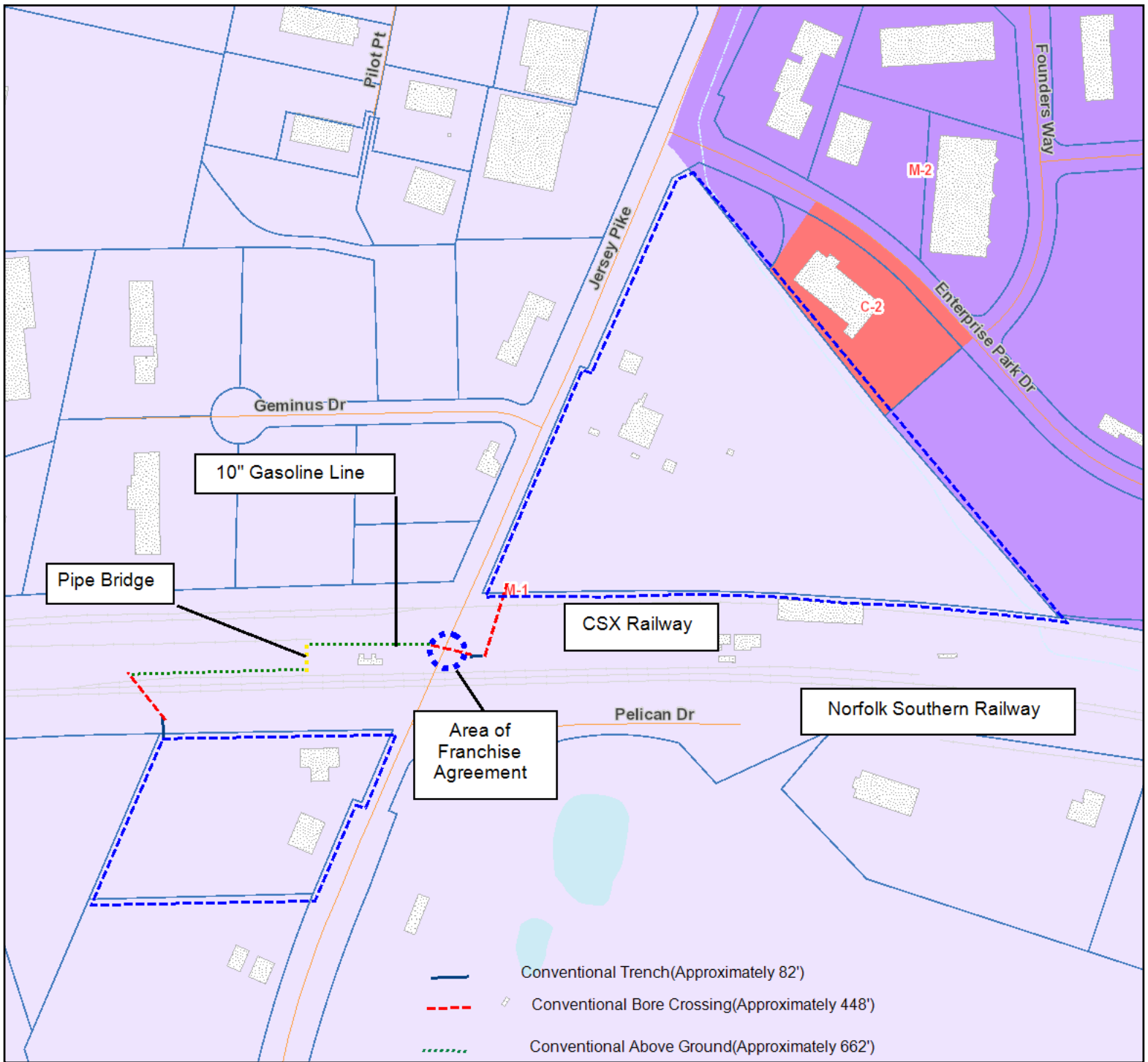
- The Highway 58 Community Plan (adopted by City Council in 2002) recommends maintaining the Mixed Industrial uses in this area.
- The M-1 Manufacturing Zone permits most types of industrial and non-residential uses, but does not permit residential uses.

**Key Findings**

- The proposal is supported by the recommendations of the adopted Land Use Plan for the area due to its support of industrial uses.
- The proposed use is consistent and compatible with surrounding uses.
- The proposal would set a precedent for future requests.
- This is a reasonable request to help facilitate the continued fuel distribution services in this area provided that all state and local requirements and provisions are fully satisfied relative to public health and safety.

**Staff Recommendation**

Approve.
